D0801- 3D DENTAL SURFACE SCAN

- Cerec Scans not typically reimbursed except possibly part of Ortho Work Up
- Maybe reimbursed at 50%

CONE BEAM

- D0360 was deleted
- D0380 CBCT less than one whole jaw
- D0381 CBCT one full dental arch mandible
- D0382 CBCT One full dental arch maxilla
- D0383 CBCT of Both Jaws
- D0384 CBCT for TMJ

TOMOSYNTHESIS

• Small slices of a tooth to create a 3D image of a footh or teeth

D0387 - Full mouth

D0388 – Bitewing

D0709 FULL MOUTH

- Intraoral Complete Comprehensive series of radiographic images
- A radiographic survey of the whole mouth, usually consisting of 14-22 images (periapical and posterior bitewing as indicated) intended to display the crowns and roots of all teeth, periapical areas, interproximal areas and alveolar bone including edentulous areas.

D0393 VIRTUAL TREATMENT SIMULATION USING 3-D IMAGE VOLUME OR SURFACE SCAN

- The use of 3D image volumes for Virtual simulation of treatment including, but not limited to, dental implant placement, prosthetic reconstruction, orthogonathic surgery and orthodontic tooth movement.
- Digital Wax Ups and Smile Design
- Using Cerec and CBCT to simulate implant crown and placement

RESIN-BASED COMPOSITE INLAYS

- Milled Fillings for Cerec
- **D2651** 2 surface
- **D2652** 3 surface

 Insurance will downgrade them to Amalgams/ Composites

PORCELAIN/CERAMIC VS RESIN

 50% inorganic filler (porcelain, glasses, ceramics and glass-ceramics) is what determines Porcelain vs Resin

REMOVAL OF NON-RESORBABLE BARRIER

 D4286 The removal of the barrier is typically considered in the global fee for placing the barrier. Do not expect reimbursement

D4355 DEBRIDEMENT

- FULL MOUTH DEBRIDEMENT TO ENABLE A COMPREHENSIVE ORAL Periodontal EVALUATION AND DIAGNOSIS ON A SUBSEQUENT VISIT
- Full mouth debridement involves the preliminary removal of plaque and calculus that interferes with the ability of the dentist to perform a comprehensive oral evaluation. Not to be completed on the same day as <u>D0150</u>, <u>D0160</u>, or <u>D0180</u>.

D6105 IMPLANT REMOVAL SIMPLE

- Removal of implant body not requiring bone removal or flap elevation.
- D6105 may also be considered a simple removal of implant
- D6100 is considered surgical removal of implant when flap and bone removal

GUIDED TISSUE REGENERATION - IMPLANTS

- D6106 Resorbable membrane
- D6107 Non resorbable membrane

 These procedures can be used for peri-implant defects and at implant placement

D6197

• **D6197** Replacement of restorative material used to close and access opening of a screw-retained implant supported prosthesis per implant

• Most likely be denied by payors and will be a out of pocket expense.

D7956 AND D7957

- D7956 Guided Tissue Regeneration, Edentulous area resorbable barrier.
- D7957 Guided Tissue Regeneration, Edentulous area non-resorbable barrier.

These procedure may be used for ridge augmentation, sinus lift procedures and after tooth extraction
